PONTOON USE POLICY

6 September, 2021 (Amending original Policy adopted 1 October, 2013 as per by-law 4)

The life of this Document is three years unless amended/withdrawn by the Management Committee, Bundaberg Sailing Club, Inc.

The Bundaberg Sailing Club Inc. accepts no responsibility or liability for any vessel secured to the Pontoon or Ramp.

The Pontoon is for the use of all members of the Bundaberg Sailing Club.

The Pontoon may also be used by other members of the Sailing Fraternity, on approval being granted by a current Management Committee Member.

Due to the size of the Pontoon and its close proximity to the Club's Launching Ramp, TIME LIMITS are imposed on the securing of vessels to the pontoon, i.e.

- 1. On days that are advised for Club activities including competitive sailing, sail training, regattas etc the time limit is "no longer than Twenty (20) minutes".
- 2. On days that Sailability Bundaberg conduct sail training the use of the pontoon is restricted for their exclusive use only.
- 3. On other days the time limit is one-half (1/2) day, or longer where the owner/skipper is in attendance of the vessel, and approval has been granted by a current Management Committee Member.
- 4. In the case of an emergency the above time limits may be waived at the discretion of a current Management Committee Member.
- 5. The Club's and Sailability's Safety/Rescue boat/boats have priority to the shore-side position on the Pontoon at all times.

No major repairs or maintenance are to be carried out whilst tied/secured to the Pontoon.

No refuse or other rubbish is to be left on the Pontoon or walkway and the responsibility for removal remains with the vessel's skipper.

No fishing, diving or jumping from the Pontoon or walkway is allowed.
